



DUCHESNE COLLEGE COUNCIL BURSARY

Commencing in 2007, the Duchesne College Council Bursary will be awarded with the object of assisting a Duchesne College student to complete her undergraduate university degree.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Interpretation

In these conditions:

“Award” shall mean the Duchesne College Council Bursary;

“Scholar” shall mean the person holding the award;

“College” shall mean Duchesne College.

2. Introduction

The College has established the Duchesne College Council Bursary to provide financial assistance to students who, because of their financial circumstances, would otherwise be unable to remain in residence whilst completing their undergraduate university studies.

3. Administration

The Awards shall be administered by and made on the recommendation of the Duchesne College Council. The Principal shall present a short list of candidates for Council consideration. The Council reserves the right not to award a bursary in any given year.

4. Eligibility

The Awards are available to all students enrolled on a full-time undergraduate university degree who are returning to Duchesne College after having completed at least one full academic year at university while living at the College. Applicants are required to have a GPA score of 5.00 or above. Documentary evidence of this is required. Holders of a Commonwealth Accommodation Scholarship or other scholarships are eligible for a Duchesne College Council Bursary.

5. Value & Payments

5.1 The Awards are to the value of 50% remission of the College Annual Fee, which will be applied at the commencement of each academic semester.

5.2 There are two Duchesne College Council Bursaries available annually.

5.3 On the advice of the Selection Committee, two further bursaries to the value of 25% remission of the College Annual Fee may be offered.

6. Duration of Award

The Award shall be tenable for the duration of the scholar's undergraduate studies but shall be subject to annual review in accordance with the selection criteria.

If the scholar fails to comply with the provisions of the award, the Council may terminate the award or withhold any further emoluments. Where an award is cancelled pursuant to the provisions of this clause it may, for the remainder of the term for which the original holder would have been entitled to it, be awarded to another suitable candidate.

7. Selection Criteria

The Award will be made on the basis of:

- (a) commitment to the degree discipline undertaken and satisfactory academic progress (as indicated by the applicant's GPA).
- (b) commitment to the life and service of Duchesne College;
- (c) leadership and personal qualities;
- (d) financial need;

The Council will take into account other awards, bursaries and/or scholarships in its ranking of the applications.

8. Awarding of Bursaries

1. All applicants will be interviewed by the Selection Committee comprising the Principal, Vice Principal and a member of the Duchesne College Council in the week commencing Monday 31st August 2009.
 2. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application on or before Friday 18th September 2009.
