You must complete a total of 68 units for the program.

Bachelor of Business Management Requirements:

- ❖ 36 units from the BBusMan List including
 - 24 units of compulsory courses from Group 1; and
 - Either:
 - o 12 units from one major in Group 2 (minimum 6 units must be at level 3); OR
 - 12 units of elective courses from Group 3 (minimum 6 units must be at level 3, and maximum 2 units may be at level 1).

Bachelor of Arts Requirements:

- 32 units from Part A and/or Part B of the BA List including either—
 - Two majors of 16 units each; or
 - One extended major of 24 units (28 units Psychology) plus balance in BA List electives; or
 - One major of 16 units and two minors of 8 units each (a minor consists of 8 units in total, chosen from one major list, with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include one gateway course and one cornerstone course).
