You must complete 64 units, comprising -

- 20 units for compulsory courses from Part A of the BBusMan course list (excluding ACCT1101 and FINM1416) and Part A of the BCom course list; and
- 16 units for a BBusMan major; and
- 16 units for a BCom major; and
- 12 units for general elective courses

#### Note:

Excluding Part A courses, no more than 8 units may be level 1 courses
