### **Bachelor of Commerce (BCom) Requirements:**

- 32 units from the BCom List including
  - 16 units of compulsory courses from Part A; and
  - 16 units for a major in Part B

### **Bachelor of Arts (BA) Requirements:**

- ❖ 32 units from the BA List including either—
  - Two BA Majors of 16 units each; or
  - One BA Extended Major of 24 units plus a BA Minor of 8 units.
