

Graduate Certificate in Business Leadership

1 Definitions

In these rules—

approved cohort means one or more persons from a particular company or a corporate client as approved by the executive dean.

2 Enrolment requirements

(a) To enrol in the program, a person must—

- (i) hold an approved degree (or equivalent), with a GPA of 4; or
- (ii) have completed post-secondary study and five years' full-time (or equivalent) work experience, approved by the executive dean; or
- (iii) have completed seven years' full-time (or equivalent) work experience, approved by the executive dean; and

(b) be part of an approved cohort.

3 Field of study

A student must undertake the program in a field approved by the executive dean.

4 Program requirements

To complete the program, a student must complete 8 units from the GCBusLead list.

5 Maximum credit for other study

The maximum credit that the associate dean (academic) may grant to a student for other study is 4 units.
